- 2018 W-2 forms or year-end paystubs
- 2018 untaxed income records such as child support received, veterans non-education benefits, tax-exempt interest income, or worker's compensation
- Current information on any checking & savings account balances or other investments
- Student and parent FSA ID (if you have already made one at fsaid.ed.gov)
- Student's Green Card or Alien Registration Number (if applicable)
